The role would ideally suit someone based at Devonport and surrounding suburbs.

We are a family owned company that has been operating for over 90 years. We have operations in Hobart, Launceston, Devonport and Burnie, and workshops in both Hobart and Launceston.

About the role

The positions require a person who has excellent customer service skills and enjoys working with people.

The role is primarily a regular commuter service run between Devonport and Launceston twice a week. One day will be an 8.5 hour shift with a 6:30am start, and the second regular shift will be a 5 hour shift with a 3pm start. Ideally this will be Wednesday and Friday, respectively, however we can be flexible on which weekdays these shifts occur.

Additionally, we will offer you additional casual hours on an ad hoc basis that would require you to cover a variety of different charter services. The hours will be variable and will likely include some weekend and public holiday work.

You will be responsible for safely operating the designated service, and may also be required to undertake ticketing, assisting passengers on and off your vehicle, and may be required to assist in the loading and unloading of luggage.

About you

To succeed in the role, it is necessary to have a strong attention to detail, an ability to quickly learn and operate booking & communication systems, have a good driving record and an ability

to safely transport passengers to their destinations. Knowledge of the geography of Burnie and Devonport is highly desirable.
